

The cost of the Optomap retinal imaging is \$39 and is not covered by insurance.

Please initial one of the following:

PREFERRED: Optomap Retinal Exam

- An in-depth view of the retinal layers (where diseases can start)
- The ability for you to view your Optomap image at the time of your exam

Traditional dilation utilizing drops to dilate your pupil. This method requires 20 minutes to take effect and will dilate the pupils for 2-4 hours. Your vision will be temporarily blurry and sensitive to light. Complications from the drops are rare, but if you should experience pain in or around your eyes, hazy vision (halos around lights), or a sick feeling, please contact our doctors as soon as possible.
